Irregular Verbs: Overview and List

Irregular Verbs: Overview and List In English, regular verbs consist of three main parts: the root form (present), the (simple) past, and the past participle Regular verbs have an -ed ending added to the root verb for both the simple past and past participle Irregular verbs do not follow this pattern, and instead take on an alternative pattern

Rules for Using Irregular Verbs

1 RULES FOR USING IRREGULAR VERBS Understand the problem All verbs, whether regular or irregular, have five forms [often called principal parts] These forms are the infinitive, simple present, simple past, past participle, and present participle The difference between a regular and an irregular verb is the formation of the simple

Regular Verbs Most verbs are regular verbs, so they follow the same predictable pattern In this pattern, the past tense adds an -ed to the base form of the verb I work I worked The perfect tenses then use that -ed form to form what is called the past participle: I have worked I ...
